

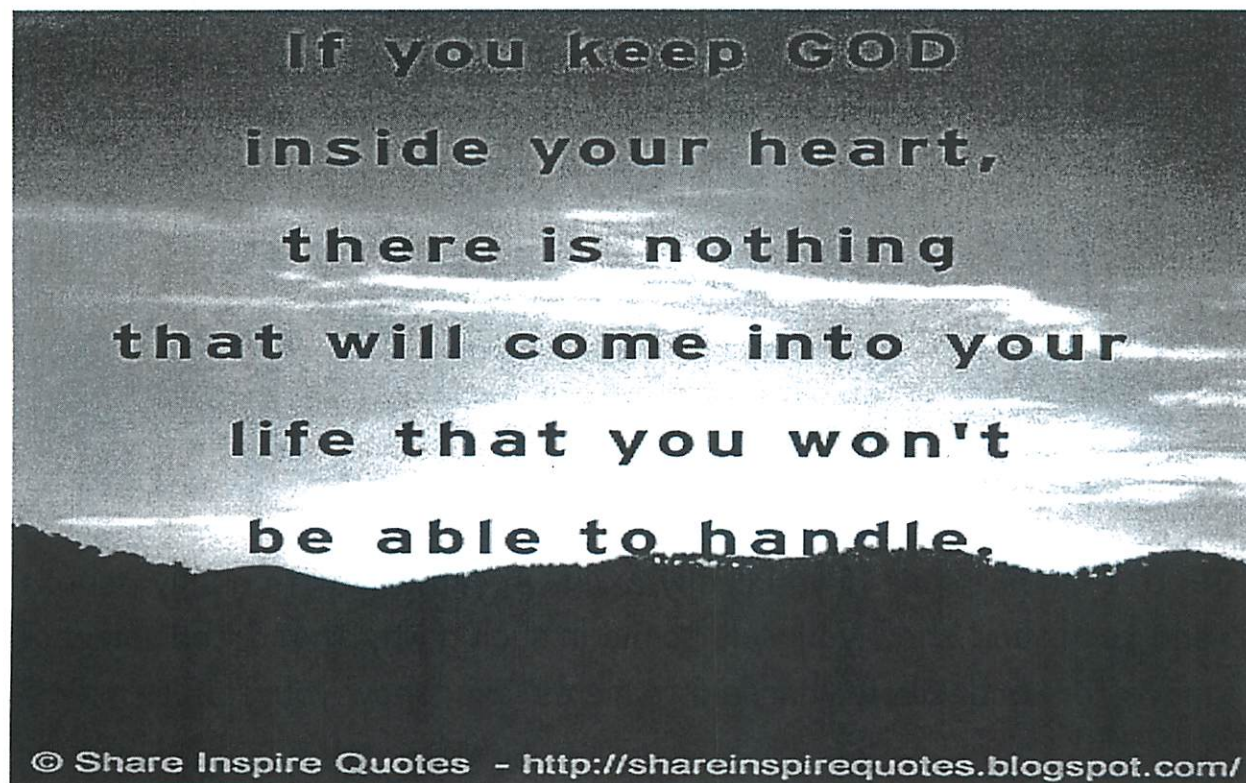


Year 10/11 Assembly
