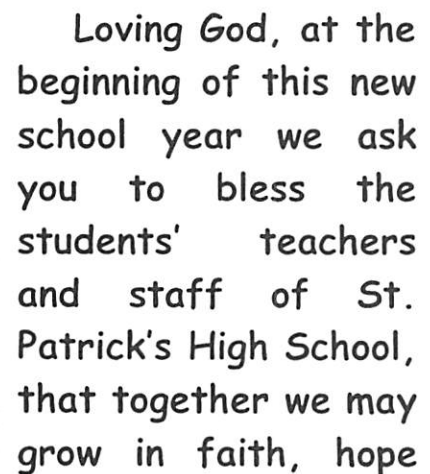

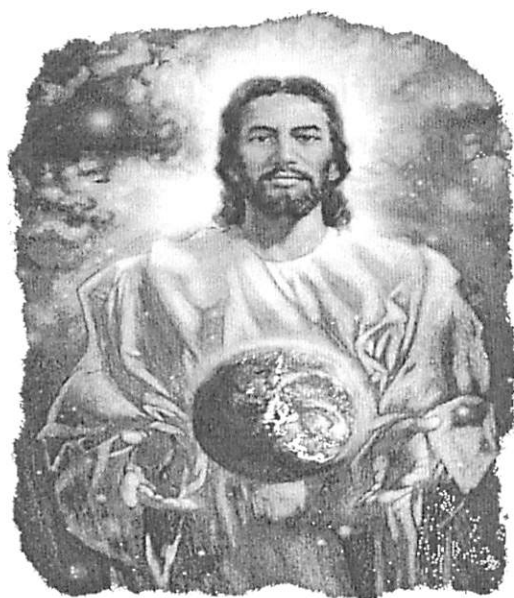


3. Lord, as we face challenges during the year, guide us with your light.

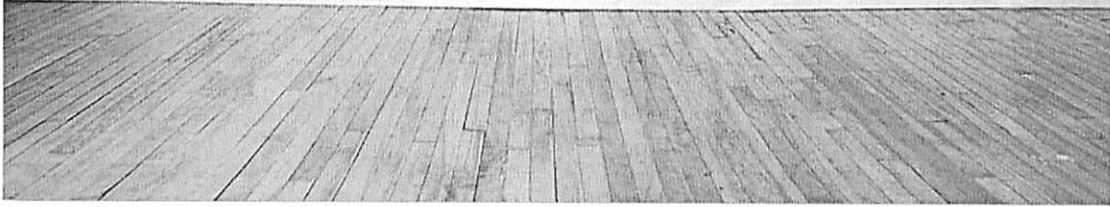
Closing Prayer

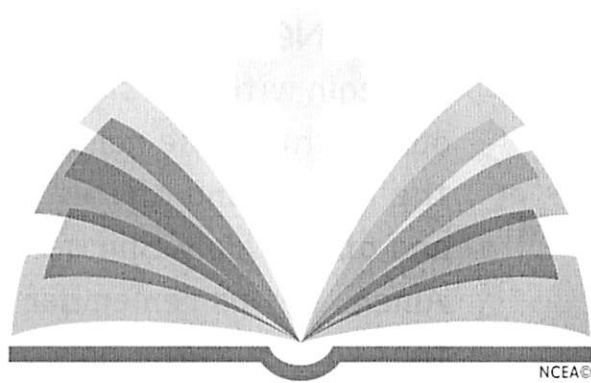
This can be prayed by the whole group or by the leader - just say 'Together we pray,...

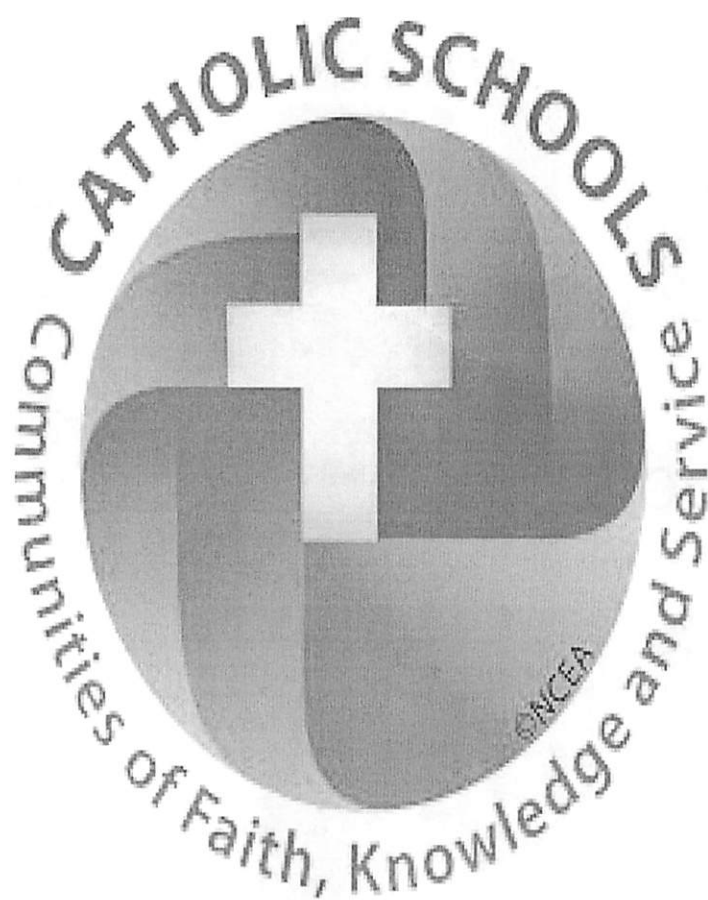
Prayer Service to Begin a New School Year

to you in the name of Jesus, the Lord. Amen.

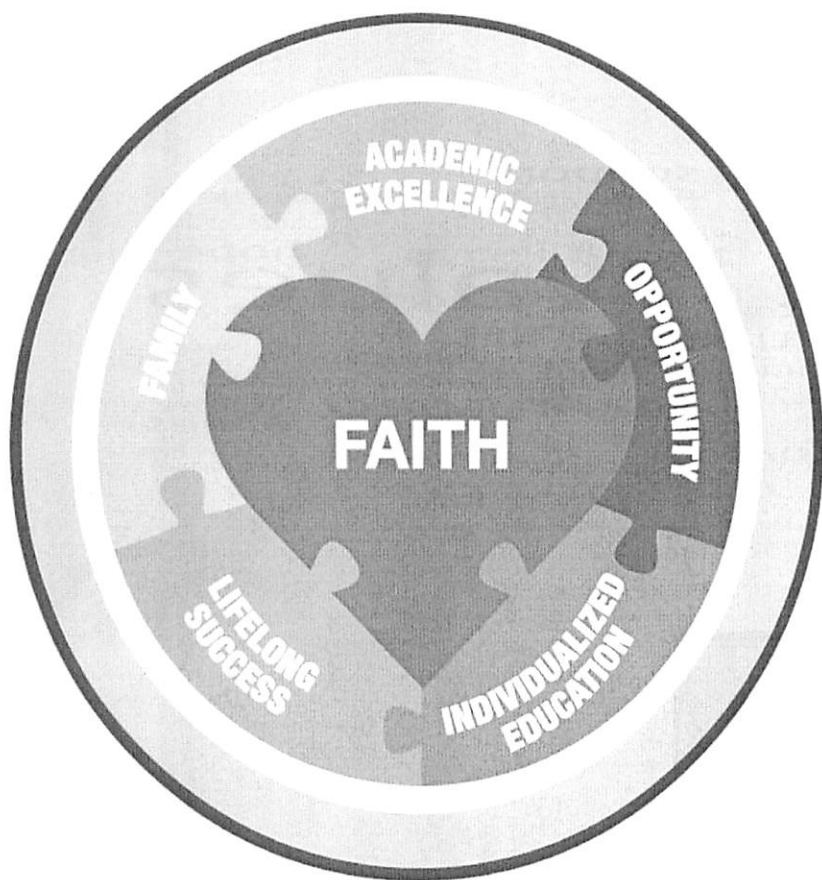
And now, let us listen to God's word.
